OBO has full-time, Arlington, VA-based opportunities in the following areas and many more:

- Management/Program/Data Analysts (0343): ensure OBO programs, operations, and processes deliver intended results.
- General Engineers (0801): advise on, administer, supervise, or perform professional, scientific, or technical work concerned with engineering or architectural projects, facilities, structures, or systems
- Architects (0808): manage, supervise, lead, or perform professional architecture work involving the art and science of conceptualizing, planning, developing, and implementing designs to ensure buildings and structures are responsive to human activities and needs; structurally sound and permanent facilities.

- Electrical Engineers (0850): Prepare electrical design drawings, calculations, and specifications to accompany design models.
- Data Scientists (1560): identify the methods, processes, algorithms, tools, and systems to extract and interpret findings from varied structured and unstructured data sets.
- Interior Designers (1008): perform, supervise, or manage work related to the design of interior environments in order to promote employee productivity, health, and welfare, and/or the health and welfare of the public.
