
STEPS TO BECOMING A **DIPLOMATIC SECURITY** SERVICE SPECIAL AGENT

STEP 1:

REVIEW THE VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT AND CONFIRM YOUR ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY (2)

View the Diplomatic Security Service Special Agent Vacancy Announcement.





STEP 2: SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION (2)

Submit your online application at www.personvue.com/DSSAT. The application includes a self-assessment, education and professional experience, Personal Narrative questions and a Statement of Interest. Your application must be complete and submitted in order to register for the DSSAT.



STEP 3:

TAKE THE DIPLOMATIC SECURITY SERVICE SPECIAL AGENT TEST (DSSAT) 2

Register to take the DSSAT at a time and Pearson Vue location that is convenient to you.





STEP 4: **SUBMIT EDUCATION AND** MILITARY DOCUMENTATION (2)

After passing the DSSAT, you will recieve an email with directions on how to submit your education and military documents (if applicable) by a specific deadline. You must submit your documents by the deadline to qualify for the Qualifications Evaluation Panel.



Your application, education documents, and DSSAT scores will be reviewed by a Qualifications Evaluation Panel. Successful candidates will be invited to the Oral Assessment.

TAKE THE DIPLOMATIC SECURITY SERVICE SPECIAL **AGENT ASSESSMENT** The Assessment is conducted in person at DSS Offices






SUITABILITY REVIEW PANEL (2)

A Suitability Review Panel will examine your completed file (exept for medical records) to determine your suitability for a




career in the Foreign Service.

STEP 9:

The Physical Readiness Test (PRT) measures muscular endurance and aerobic capacity. You must achieve a passing score on the PRT



to continue your candidacy. **Prepare for the PRT.**







STEP 10: REGISTER OF CLEARED

CANDIDATES (2)

After you've successfully passed all steps, your name is placed on the Register, which is a rank-ordered list of successful candidates.
