Lateral Entry Pilot Program

- An opportunity for entry into the Foreign Service at the mid-level (grades FP-03 and FP-02).
- LEPP seeks mid-level professionals with expertise in the following critical areas:
 - 1. Cyberspace and emerging technologies
 - 2. Climate, environment and energy
 - 3. Global health security and diplomacy
 - 4. Strategic competition with the People's Republic of China
 - 5. Economic statecraft
 - 6. Consular management
 - 7. Multilateral diplomacy



Conditions of Employment

- Be a <u>U.S. citizen</u> at the time of application
- Be 21 years old and not yet 60 on the day you are appointed
- Accept assignments based on needs of the service
- Be able to obtain Top Secret <u>Security</u> Clearance
- Meet Minimum <u>Medical</u> Qualification Standard
- Obtain a favorable <u>Suitability Review</u>
 <u>Panel</u> Determination



Determination of Grade

FP-03 grade:

- A bachelor's degree, with 10 years of specialized experience; or
- A master's degree with 8 years of specialized experience; or
- A PhD degree with 6 years of specialized experience

FP-02 grade:

- A bachelor's degree, with 12 years of specialized experience; or
- A master's degree with 10 years of specialized experience; or
- A PhD degree with 8 years of specialized experience
- Foreign language proficiency
- Supervisory experience at least four years directly supervising others

Consular Management Expertise

- Processing **casework** pertaining to nonimmigrant, immigrant, and/or citizenship eligibility.
- Supervisory **emergency or crisis** management specialist
- Supervisory customer service
- Senior project or program manager
- Supervision of teams comprised of 10 individuals or more in international relations or international law.





Actions Performed in Specialized Expertise









- Work in government, private sector, academia, or nonprofit
- Monitor/analyze policy recommendations
- Draft policy documents and/or defend policy
- Experience in the laws, regulations, treaties, and agreements governing the development and execution of U.S. policy
- Negotiate at a local, state, federal, or international level
- Plan and organize for international audiences
- Communications, public affairs, or media relations related to expertise

LEPP Selection Process

- 1. Apply via USAJobs.gov
 - Choose career track
- 2. Submit personal narratives:
 - Leadership; Communication; Interpersonal; Management; Intellectual; Substantive Knowledge + motivation
- 3. Qualifications Evaluation Panel
- 4. Receive invitation to the Foreign Service Officer Assessment (FSOA)
 - 1) Group Exercise; 2) Case Management; 3) Structured Interview
 - Pass given conditional offer
- Minimum Medical Standard
- 6. Security Clearance
- 7. Suitability Review Panel
- 8. Hiring Register
- 9. Hired from Register at FP-03 or FP-02

Foreign Service Generalists Career Path

- LEPP hires follow Foreign Service Generalists career path.
- Must be tenured within five years
- LEPP hires required to complete 1 directed assignment in their area of expertise.
- Following the directed assignment, LEPP hires will **bid** as a mid-level FSO.
- LEPP hires receive full Foreign Service Generalists **benefits**.




