Program Requirements

- U.S. Citizen
- Degree Seeking, Enrolled Domestic or Overseas Student
- 10 Hours Per Week
- Virtual and Unpaid 9 Month Academic Program
- High School Graduate

Our Application Process



Mentors Post Projects (January)

Federal employees and contractors register as project mentors and submit unclassified projects on the VSFS website, vsfs.state.gov.



Students Apply (February)

Students submit their applications.



Applications Reviewed (March-April)

Project mentors review applications and conduct interviews.



Interns Selected (No later than May)

Accepted interns are notified.



Projects Begin (September)

Students and mentors begin working on their projects together! Internships run through the end of the academic year.
